ANNUAL REPORT 2022-23

June 1st 2022, will remain one of the most memorable days for our teachers and students because after the pandemic and disorder, we were going to start a new academic year 2022-23. The school strength had gone up to 1097. We began with a huge faith on the magic of beginnings and with a hope that this would be another great Academic year.

The eventful year marked its beginning with the Teachers Orientation Week and two parent orientation programs which showed the way the school would be conducted and what the parents could expect. Followed by this the first programme was the World Environment Day. To bring awareness and to be a part of local community we had a road march as well as a street play demonstrating the need to preserve the environment.

Teachers' professional development is a part of the curriculum. We have had a week long Staff Training programme, followed by Teachers Training programs at different CBSE schools and STGPS conducting CBSE Training for 60 teachers including teachers from neighboring CBSE schools.

To emphasize and reinforce the concept of culture, tradition, values, ethics and morals, all the Religious and National festivals were observed and celebrated in our school. Student Council Elections, Investiture ceremony, International Yoga Day, Monsoon Marathon, Dassara, Deepavali, Krishna Janmashtami, Independence Day, Suraksha Bandhana, Teachers Day, Children's Day and Kannada Rajyotsava are to name a few .

Academic has been our core concern and as a testimony we received fantastic results in our 10th Board exams. Asra Mahin topped the school with 97.4% followed by 15 students scoring distinction. Competency based Education with a focus on Learning Outcome is our goal. Regular assessments were done as a part of the academics. The student's performance was analyzed and the remedial were conducted to help the students perform better. ILM is conducting Spoken English classes to help students communicate in English. As a part of this the students' edition of the English newspaper was also subscribed which could aid in their reading habits. Science Olympiad was conducted to instill curiosity and competition among students. The students were given opportunities to speak, write,

draw, sing and dance as part of many literary competitions and Inter school activities to promote the holistic development of the children.

CCA Activities like Swimming, Karate, Music and Dance kept the students engaged and attracted to the school life. There were 8 inter-house literary activities conducted in which Chaturya house emerged victorious. Our students have brought laurels in various Inter school events. We won many prizes in Taluk level Pratibha Karanji. Ms. Parinitha of 10th std won first prize in Kannada Kavigoshti at Kautilya Vidyalaya. A bunch of 30 students participated in an array of activities in Delhi Public School and we bagged most of the prizes there too. Mst. Dhuvan Gowda participated in State level Skating and he stood second in it. International Handwriting Rating Agency has recognized two students with Handwriting Excellence certificates. They are Mst. Mahanth of VI std and Ms. Shreya Poojary of VIII. This year our school won 'Dynamic School award' and Best school in 'Teachers well being and Advancement'.

This year one of the most magnificent program was signing an MOU with Saginaw Valley State University. This MOU entitles both the institutions to share the learning, culture and accomplishments. Students and staff of both institutions can be part of a Cultural Exchange program starting from next Academic Year.
