

5. We had Computerized Voting for Student Council Elections. Elected members **Ms. Sonu** as Head Girl, **Mst. Mohitha** as Head Boy along with other council members got their badges pinned in Investiture Ceremony from **Guru Divyapadaji** of Art of Living.
6. The students of the school are divided into four different houses, **Shourya**, **Sthairya**, **Dhairya**, **Chaturya**. Various literary and Sports competitions were held throughout the year and the Best house of the year award goes to **Sthairya**. House excelling in sports is Chaturya. Junior Literary Champion is **Himashree** from 4th std, Senior Literary Champion is **Likhitha H G** from 6th std. Sports Champions are **Prajwal BB** of 10th & **Suhasini Ambiger** of 10th std.
7. We sent our school teams for CBSE Swimming, Kabbadi, Skating and Athletics. Our performance there was remarkable. **Mst. Dhuvan** bagged a Gold medal at regional level and moved on to participate in Nationals and won Bronze medal there enhancing our joy in our decennial year.
8. Literary Competitions Committee successfully conducted Competitions like Drawing and Painting, Elocution, Rangoli, Fireless cooking, Worth out of Waste, Creative writing English and Kannada, Mask making etc.


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9. Participation in the PratibhaKaranji, Science Olympiad, Spell beecontest, has given the students a chance to prove their skills.

A team of 9 delegates from Saginaw valley state University headed by **Dr. James Tarr**, Dean and **Dr. David Cline**, Coordinator of India Program visited the school and participated in all our activities from 3rd August to 10th August. Our Art exhibition Kalavaibhav and Robotics display was much appreciated by them.
11. The school had organized one day Field Trip for the students. The students of Pre-primary classes to 10th graders were taken to various places in and around Mandya. 10th std students got a wonderful opportunity to go to Hyderabad for three days on a school study tour.
12. Our NCC wing is proactive in making our students smart, tough and disciplined. The contingent has 50 students lead by **Mr. Naveen and Mr. Prasanna**
13. Along with these, various events were celebrated with a lot of vigour and fun. Some of them are: World Environment day, Investiture Ceremony, World Yoga Day, Kalavaibhava, Marathon, Independence Day, etc. and now the Dashmanotsava.
